Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

Organizing Authority: Miramar Yacht Club, Sheepshead Bay, New York

1. Eligibility and Entry

- 1.1 This regatta is open to Ensign Class yachts of Miramar Yacht Club
- 1.2 The Entry fee is \$50 to be received by 12:00 July 28th, 2018; Covers all Ensign Class Regattas in 2018.
- 1.3 Participation in the Regatta shall be announced no later than 12:00 July 28th, 2018
- 1.4 Ensign Class Lobel Regatta is a Non-Spinnaker race.

2. Rules

- 2.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.

3. Schedule

- 3.1 Captain's meeting - 11:30am. First warning signal – around 12:55pm

4. Courses and Marks

- 4.1 Starting Line – Coney Island Cannel C13 (green) – Committee Boat (or Yellow mark)
- 4.2 The courses and marks are subjects to change due to weather and wind condition.

5. Signals

- 5.1 5 minutes before start. Warning signal. One sound signal. Ensign class flag is displayed.
- 5.2 4 minutes before start. Preparatory signal One sound signal. P flag is displayed.
- 5.3 1 minute before start. One minute. One long sound signal. P flag is removed.
- 5.4 0 minutes. The Start. One sound signal. Ensign class flag is removed.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 Ensign Class Lobel is three races regatta. Subject to change due wind/weather conditions.
- 6.2 Boat finished first in each race scores ¼ points; second boat scores 2 points; third boat – 3 points and so on.
- 6.3 Boat scored lowest total points out of all three races wins the regatta.

7. Communication

- 7.1 Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 68 for communication with the race committee.
- 7.2 Except for emergencies or a protest, a boat shall not make radio transmission while racing.
- 7.3 Use of cell phones is permitted for matters not related to racing.
- 7.4 A boat shall not receive help from any outside source, except for illness, injury, danger or because of a collision.
- 7.5 A boat that gains a significant advantage in the race from help received from other sources may be protested and penalized. Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 68 for communication with the race committee.
- 7.6 Except for emergency, a boat is not permitted to make radio transmission while racing.

8. Disclaimer of Liability

- 8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.
- 8.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9. Social Events

- 9.1 After Race Party. Start - 17:00-18:00 – Lobel Regatta Party. Fees - \$15 per seat
